

## Suitable trees and tall shrubs to replace dying or dead trees in Pinecrest Community

Note that only native trees and ones already present in the community are included. The listed species and varieties are mostly under 50 feet tall or shorter, so less likely to damage homes. Species susceptible to dying from drought, disease or insects are not included (e.g., Dogwood & Ash). Prices vary by size of the pot and the supplier.

Black Gum (Gum Tupelo) 30-50' tall (Coffers \$70), also Kinsey Family Farm. leaves red in Spring & Fall, black berries eaten by birds	Arborvitae Emerald, 15-18' tall x 3-4' wide (Coffers \$40 - \$130), also at Kinsey Family Farm. DeGroot's Spire is 20' tall x 4-5' wide
Fringe Tree (Old Man's Beard, <i>Chionanthus virginicus</i> ) ,12-30' tall (Coffers \$35-90), Kinsey Family Farm & The FamilyTree Garden Cntr.	Greenleaf American Holly (The Tree Center \$140)
American Hornbeam (Musclewood), 20-30' tall, Kinsey Family Farm	Magnolia grandiflora (Brakens Beauty, Teddy Bear, Little Gem) (Coffers \$50 to \$130+), also Kay Parris & Brakens, Kinsey Family Farm
Hophornbeam, 25-40' (Coffers \$40 to \$60)	Magnolia virginiana (Sweetbay) (Coffers \$50), also at Kinsey Family Farm
Red Mullberry 20-30' (Coffers \$40), has edible fruit used in baking, eaten by birds	
American Plum, 20-30' tall (Coffers \$40, & the FamilyTree Center), not great wildlife food but good for jam, has thorns with age	
Paw Paw, (Home Depot, \$35 for 1 gal.)	
Sourwood, Wilson Bros Gardens (\$170)	
American Yellowwood, Kentucky Yellowwood 30-50' tall, often multi-stemmed, Kinsey Family Farm	
Eastern Red Cedar, 40-50' tall, no suppliers

River Birch 40-60' tall (Kinsey Family Farm, The FamilyTree Garden Center)	Southern Wax Myrtle, 15-30' tall, great fruit for birds, (\$35 Coffers, Kinsey Family Farm & The Family Tree Center
Serviceberry, 15-25' tall (Coffers \$60), also Kinsey Family Farm, good fruit for birds	
Nannyberry ( <i>Viburnum lentago</i> ) 20-25' tall (Coffers \$40)	
Crape Myrtle (not native) -20' (\$40 to \$80)	
Japanese Maple (not native) (\$100+)
